English part= content

Deadlines: _____ = cv and video; _____ the website explained in class

Pre-requisite : the minimum that I will evaluate is a mock-up and the content of the pages . The vocabulary has been corrected at the 1st oral. No more vocab mistakes. Your website should include:

1. homepage and cv all in one: your CV + **picture** on the top left.

1st name, last name and subtitle below: state you first name and last name, what studies you are currently in and a few words about your experience, personal or educational and how it is linked with your aspirations and personality.

Choose a nice picture on the top left. Your cv must occupy one whole page and use up all the space.

You have 3 zones:

1 **education** now and last year. It is the **main body**. (minimum 6 lines with bullet points or keywords. You must explain what you are learning , how the subjects are linked and relevant and what tasks you can do . Don't forget Marketing, communication , English expression, making presentations, auditing websites, writing... Do not use acronyms that have no meaning to outsiders .

Explain what is MMI, (multimedia and internet)

-what is a BUT: write professional BA directly

2 **skills** minimum :the softwares you are learning now.

Don't hesitate to use larger fonts. It must be very easy to read. Use at least 2 colors, highlighting personal experience and internships.

Prefer dark fonts over white , Use big fonts and bold for key words

State your skills, softwares, and explain you will enclose illustrations on the following page

3 professional experience

2. second page **illustrating** your skills and personal work, with **pictures, links** for personal work like videos, animations or channels or music making. It is like a mini portfolio.
3. Video detailed below (with button on top/header of homepage)
-you should have a link with a **video** of yourself making a pitch in 1.30mm maximum, You can frame your face but also your work, in action
4. a 3rd page containing a prospect of your possible career, explaining what jobs (at least 3) you could do and explain them in 10 lines each : ex game designer, artistic director, community manager, communications assistant, graphist, UI/UX designer, screenwriter, sound engineer.... Answer the questions: what does he do? Who works with him, who is he responsible for?

ABOUT THE VIDEO : 1MN30 minimum, up to 1MN40

The background is neutral (no parasite object behind) or outdoors . Watch out for light reflection on glasses. Pay attention to sound. Pay attention to light : if you are indoors , have multiple sources of light; AVOID being in front of the computer camera: you will have a blue light you want to avoid.. Pay attention to your outfit. Be professional

You should take **20 seconds** max framing **your face**. Announce who you are and what you want to do / be:

ex "Hi, I am Meline X and I am currently studying web, multimedia and internet to be a webdesigner/ graphist/ game designer/artistic director/ community manager/UI-UX designer/web developer...My BA training includes and I already know how to... *Here you start showing your skills.*

-The rest of the time, (1MN5) 1mn should be *framed on your work, (especially the visual / graphic work)*

- last 5 sec , *back on your face to conclude* . EX "So as you see , I love drawing and I wish to integrate my skills in making websites... . I hope you enjoyed this moment , goodbye'
